You're viewing a 2004 Tiara Yachts 4200 Open DAY BREAK for sale - In Boating the term "Convertible" means a boat that can be versatile enough that it can be fished or cruised equally well. Tiara's Express/ Opens were called "Crossover" boats which have the same meaning and have long been regarded as some of the best boats for doing both. The 4200 Open is a shining example. She is built on a steep deadrise modified-V hull with prop pockets and a wide 14-foot, 11-inch beam. The 4200's spacious 85-square-foot cockpit with coaming bolsters, fresh and raw water wash downs, storage boxes, and fold-away rear seat- is also factory rigged for fishing with an optional livewell and bait prep station. The added bonus of a full tuna tower on the "Day Break" makes this model a serious fishing platform and adds substantial value to the vessel! The Cummins QSM 11ar C12s (670 hp each) give the boat a respectable range with her 525 gallons of fuel and an optimal cruise of about 23 knots and burning an economical 35-37 GPH! The below deck accommodations are airy and expansive. The lounge to port converts into a berth for two and has a great view of the flat-screen TV to starboard. The back of the lounge forms a Pullman berth for one more. To starboard, the galley features the optional teak and maple sole.

Additional Description

With plenty of room for friends, family, and gear, the Tiara 4200 Open offers room to spare, allowing any Tiara owner to travel in style. An upper cockpit wetbar with sink, cutting board, refrigerator, and insulated cooler aft mean that the sportsman and cruiser alike will have enough room for preparation and storage of bait, fish and food. An automatic rope / chain anchor windlass system with operation from foredeck foot pedal and remote switch at the helm, ensures that in high or low seas, the captain will remain in control. Four 10-inch spring line cleats and two 6-inch fender cleats mean the 4200 can be tied up safely and securely. The 4200 Open features a hull and deck constructed with a gelcoat outer layer, hand-laid fiberglass and balsa core (deck and hullsides) with a special blended premium resin. The custom composite windshield frame, with tempered safety glass, offers safety handrails, power opening center section, and three washer / wipers. Tiara's custom 12V DC and 120V / 240V AC electrical system, 50 amp battery charger, and a 12V DC 2-bank battery system with gel cell batteries, ensures heavy-duty power. Power, performance and safety are important to any Tiara owner and the 4200 engine platform is no exception. The 4200 Open will run on either the CAT C12 engine platform, equipped with the CAT MPD engine display or the Cummins diesel engine platform, equipped with the Cummins C-Cruise engine display.

The 4100 Open features a transferable 5 year limited warranty on the hull. It is constructed with a water barrier outer gelcoat layer and hand-laid fiberglass with a special formulated resin. A material called "decolite" is used for stringer material, it is CNC cut and encapsulated with fiberglass and integrated into the hull. Engine beds are tech-lam or plywood reinforced. This process creates a solid backbone which gives the 4100 Open a superior ride and eliminates the weight of solid wood stringers. The seacocks and all underwater thru-hull fittings are made of bronze, and a hullside exhaust system is used. The 4100 has six optional oval opening port lights with screens for great ventilation and natural light while below deck. The 4100 features a hullside ventilation system and gelcoated boot line graphics.
